School Uniform Policy

It is the policy that all DIS students wear the uniform, in its entirety, each day, unless special permission is given to not wear it. Uniforms can be purchased at The Children's Place, Gap, Gymboree, Target, and Meijer's. All hijabs worn by students must be white, light or dark blue "al-amira" (2-piece cotton) hijabs. Nonpatterned hijabs or pinned hijabs are permitted.

The uniform attire for each grade is as follows:

Kindergarten- 4th:

Light blue or white polo shirt and navy-blue dress pants. Optional for girls: long skirts or jumper skirts, accompanied by tights. No bare legs under skirts or jumpers are permitted.

5th-8th grade:

Boys -white polo shirt with tan khaki pants or navy-blue pants. They may also wear navy blue polo shirts with tan khaki pants.NO JEANS!

Girls: long navy shirt with tan khaki pants. Solid black Abayas maybe worn on top of the uniform. NO LEGGINGS or JEANS!

Outerwear for all students: Solid Navy blue or black sweaters, cardigans, light jackets, or vests. No hoods are allowed to be worn during school hours.

Shoes for all students: rubber soled shoes. No heels or sandals are permitted.

Hijab: Beginning in 5th grade, hijabs are required. All other students should bring one for Salat if they do not wear one. All hijabs must be white, light or dark blue "princess" (Al-Amira) 2piece, cotton hijabs.

Boys Hair: Students should not have any extreme haircuts. No half-shaved designs or layered haircuts.

Children not in proper uniform will be given a warning for 1st offense, 2nd offense will be a loss of recess, and parents will be called to pick up the child or bring a change of clothes for the 3rd offense. Please send your child properly dressed in uniform daily.
